Construction Site Warehouse Management **Automation System**



The Construction Site Warehouse Management Automation System (EreWare) was developed to document the entry and exit of materials in construction site warehouses and to generate reports. Beyond tracking entries and exits, the system provides data on stock depletion, supplier details, costs, and various other movement information. Outputs can be downloaded in multiple formats, including PDF, from the relevant screens or via email.

The details regarding the product removed from the warehouse are recorded in the system by organizing the stock quantities. Warehouse managers or company auditors can access the warehouse stock information through the web interfaces using their individual passwords.

The system operates in conjunction with the company's ERP and accounting programs through Web API interfaces. All inventory quantities and movements are synchronized in real-time with the company's software, providing detailed information.

Through its integration with the EreWare system, the cost data of materials received from the warehouse is linked to vehicle maintenance and service operations.

System

Warehouse managers access the system by entering their password and identity information through the application on their mobile devices. This ensures that the system consistently identifies warehouse manager conducting transaction.

To obtain materials from the warehouse, the warehouse manager utilizes his mobile phone to scan the RFID ID card of the receiving personnel. He then scans the product's barcode and inputs relevant information, including the exit workshop and cost center.
